GUIDELINES

- **Artists must have a connection to MS** (diagnosis, family member, care giver/partner, friend, colleague, etc.)
- **Artwork may include visual media.** Examples include paintings, sculpture, ceramics, textile, jewelry, arts/crafts, photography, poetry and graphic design.
- **Submissions must be original work** created within the last five years.
- **Please limit submission size to 30”H by 30”W.** We don’t want to limit creativity, but cannot guarantee display of works that exceed these dimensions.
- **Two art pieces, per artist maximum.** If the number of art pieces exceeds the show’s capacity, only one may be displayed.
- **Display priority will be given to people with MS.** We encourage and recommend submitting before the deadline.
- **No sales will take place at the show.** All financial transactions are the responsibility of the artist and must take place after the show.
- **Please include a photo of your artwork.** Artists will allow Swedish to use an electronic copy of their artwork for media relations on the Internet and in print.
- **Notification: The MS Center will notify all artists by Friday, June 14.** The exhibit committee reserves the right in its sole discretion to determine which artwork will be included.
- **Informed consent.** Swedish Medical Center, MS Center at Swedish and Seattle Center are not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of art caused before, during, transit to and from the Show, and while on display.

Submission of art confirms you will release and discharge and agree to hold harmless, Swedish Medical Center, MS Center at Swedish, Seattle Center, its employees, agents and individuals involved in creating the Show from and against all liability as a result of any harm, damage, and/or loss of art.
