What is a pediatric hospitalist?

Swedish pediatric hospitalists are board-certified pediatricians who are dedicated to caring for children exclusively in a hospital setting. While your child is hospitalized, the hospitalist will direct their treatment course as well as assist in coordinating with any needed specialists or other members of your child's care team.

Our pediatric hospitalists are in the hospital 24 hours a day, every day, so they can closely monitor your child's progress and quickly respond to changes that may occur in your child's condition, day or night. If your child is hospitalized for several days, you may meet more than one hospitalist. However, they communicate closely as a team to help ensure continuity of care.

Will my child's primary care physician or pediatrician be involved while my child is in the hospital?

Our pediatric hospitalists communicate regularly with your child's primary care provider so that they are aware of your child's hospitalization, condition and progress. At the time of your child's discharge from the hospital, a complete summary of the hospitalization will be sent to the primary care provider. This will include details of the stay, a list of discharge medications, as well as any necessary follow-up care.
